



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C34 NEAR CHEBBARD FARM, CHESELBOURNE

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along C34 NEAR TO CHEBBARD FARM, CHESELBOURNE, a distance of approximately 20 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 4th June 2018 and remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by the 29th June 2018. But it will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary.

This order will enable Dorset County Council to carry out culvert replacement works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
